



# Advanced Placement (AP) Credit

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Advanced Placement classes are college-level courses that will improve writing skills, sharpen problem solving techniques, and help develop study habits necessary for tackling rigorous coursework. Taking AP courses demonstrates to college admissions offices your maturity and readiness for college, your willingness to push yourself to the limit, and emphasizes your commitment to academic excellence. By passing AP exams, you can earn credit or advanced standing at most of the nation's colleges and universities.
