PLT responsibilities

Parents/Guardians and Students, please consider the following items carefully before signing this application to become a member of the Peer Leadership Team:

- Members of the Peer Leadership Team are expected to set an example amongst their peers and within the community. Membership on the team requires a high standard – membership in the class and on the team may be denied/revoked based upon a student’s exhibition of poor behavior.
- Poor behavior by a student may include past or present use of any harmful or illegal substances, excessive truancy, school discipline in the past, present, or future and any other violation of school, district or community policies and laws.
- The Peer Leadership Team is a class and a leadership group. This means that work will be expected in the “traditional” class sense as well as leadership and service as an extracurricular group. Participation in both elements of the Team will impact the student’s grade and credit. Please consider your current responsibilities and obligations before applying for membership on the Team.
- In order to be on the Peer Leadership Team you will be expected to complete at least 10 hours or more of service as part of the Team outside of regularly scheduled school time per quarter.
- Each student on the Peer Leadership Team will be asked to travel to various schools within the district during school time while on the team. This requires parent/guardian permission and accommodation. Please remember that the school does not provide transportation and participation on the Peer Leadership Team is optional so do not apply if you are uncomfortable with or unable to meet these unique transportation needs during school time.
- If you become a member of PLT you are expected to enroll in the PLT class and remain there for an entire year. Many students would love the opportunity to participate on the team so please do not apply if you anticipate graduating early or have other commitments, as you will deny someone else the opportunity to be on the PLT for an entire year if you are accepted.

By signing this application the student and parent or guardian agree to all Riverton High policies, Jordan School District policies and the Peer Leadership Team contract regarding student conduct. PLT members will be held to high standards as individual students. This includes the commitment to not use any harmful and/or illegal substances (alcohol, tobacco, drugs). PLT members who are rumored to use and/or are caught using any illegal substance will be immediately removed from the team. In order to avoid any accusations, it is important to avoid environments where illegal and/or inappropriate substances may be used. Examples and reputations are closely related and, as such, a bad reputation because of association may also result in removal from the Team. Removal from the team will be at the discretion of Mrs. Taylor, the advisor. Other behaviors that may result in removal or other disciplinary action include, but are not limited to, illegal gambling, theft, or other illegal activities at school or within the community, fighting, and vandalism.

We also understand the responsibilities and unique requirements of members of the Peer Leadership Team and will adhere to those understanding they require extra work and will require additional hours outside of school and may impact class credit and grade.
